

DID YOU KNOW?

More than 90% of deaf and hard of hearing children are born to hearing parents.

Children who begin early intervention have significantly better outcomes than children who started later. We've treated children as young as one month old!

12.5% of children and adolescents between 6 and 19 years old have symptoms of noise-induced hearing loss. The leading cause of this is the use of portable audio devices at high volume settings.
